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## **Results for Economic Development**

The goal of the City of Alamosa is to improve economic opportunities for our citizens by attracting new industries, improving the retail mix, establishing the community as a hub for tourism in the Valley and providing a future for our youth.

The City is looking for proposals that address the above needs. Specifically, we are looking for innovative approaches to accomplish the goals that are laid out in this document. Traditionally, the City has designated a set amount of money to be available to outside agencies to provide services to our residents. This approach asks those agencies to submit a proposal to provide a specific service with measurable goals and outcomes. The City will accept proposals that address only part of the attached requested services or proposals that address all areas. Proposals are due by Tuesday, August 1<sup>ST</sup> before 5:00 P.M. and should clearly state on the cover sheet that they are in response to the Economic Development request for results. All proposals should be submitted to the office of the City Manager and should clearly identify which areas they are proposing to provide services in. Term of service will be from January 1, 2018, to December 31, 2018. Those items listed as measurable results will be the areas for which proposals will be accountable.

## **Results**

Area 1: Help existing business to expand and/or attract additional light to medium industry

- Attract new business or help existing business expand
  - Measure 1: contact a minimum of 5 (mix of new or existing) businesses (light to medium industry) each month for possible location or expansion. Work with local entrepreneurs as appropriate
    - Measurable results – list of businesses contacted

- Measurable results - number of new businesses locating here (include list) and the total jobs added
- Measureable results – number of jobs created by expanding existing businesses or through entrepreneurs

Area 2: Improve retail mix and enhance the City’s role as hub for the valley with tourism and services

- Improve retail mix by attracting new retail providers in areas with significant leakage or helping existing business expand into area with significant leakage. Information on leakage can be obtained through the office of the City Manager. Areas with high leakage include clothing and clothing accessories, electronics and appliances, health and personal care stores, and specialty food service.
  - Measure 2: Contact minimum of 2 retailers per month for potential location or expansion in the City of Alamosa. Work with new or existing service providers to improve available service options in the Valley. Tourism oriented businesses should receive attention for the downtown area.
    - Measurable result – list of businesses contacted
    - Measurable result – number of new businesses locating in Alamosa
    - Measurable result – listing of new or expanded tourism based services/retailers
