#### Qualifications:

1. High School Diploma or equivalent
2. Successful completion of Police Academy or currently attending a POST approved academy
3. Peace Officer Certification in the State of Colorado
4. Must be at least 21 years of age
5. Must be able to legally possess a firearm

#### Automatic Disqualifications:

Any of the following factors would immediately disqualify a candidate from consideration:

- Any driver's license revocation as a Habitual Offender.
- Cheating on any portion of the selection process.
- Offering or paying a bribe.
- Use or possession of marijuana within the past 3 yrs.
- Use of illegal drugs, including the illegal use of prescription medications within the past 5 years.
- Use of anabolic steroids within the past year.
- Any sale, manufacture or distribution of any illegal or prescription drug; including marijuana.
- Dishonorable discharge from any Military branch.
- Giving a false statement or falsifying a report.
