



The City of Alamosa is accepting sealed bids for the 2018 First Street Reconstruction Project Phase II at the City of Alamosa Public Works Department, 300 Hunt Avenue, until 2:00 P. M., May 24, 2018. This year's project includes rebuilding approximately 750LF of road, utilities and infrastructure located from West of Edgemont to Monterey Ave. All ADA facilities and safety requirements will be the responsibility of the successful bidder.

Plans and specifications are on file in the Public Works Department and may be obtained with 24 hour notice for a charge of **\$100.00 for full size plans plus shipping**, none of which will be refunded. Free plans are available on-line at www.cityofalamosa.org.

Scheduling on these projects will be extremely important. The concrete replacement and replacement of utility infrastructure beneath portions of these projects are to be completed prior to the beginning of this asphalt work. All work on the tasks outlined in this IFB shall start June 15, 2018 and must be completed prior to October 1, 2018.

All bids must be submitted, and all work done in full compliance with:

- ✓ The plans and Specifications for the project
- ✓ Any special provisions for this project, and
- ✓ The 2012 City of Alamosa Standard Construction Specifications, as amended.

Bids may be hand-delivered to the Public Works Department, 300 Hunt Avenue. The bid must be placed in one envelope, securely sealed and clearly labeled "2018 First Street Reconstruction Project Phase II", in addition to the name of the bidder and the bidder's address on the outside of the envelope. The City of Alamosa shall not be responsible for premature opening of bids not properly labeled. All bids are to be submitted on the basis of cash payment for the work and materials and executed by the bidder as principal.

Only those bids received by the Public Works Department on or before the aforesaid date and hour set for closing of this Invitation for Bid (IFB) will be eligible for consideration. Any bid received after the closing time, regardless of the method of delivery, shall be returned unopened to the bidder. Bids may not be withdrawn after closing time.

All bids shall be evaluated and selections made as soon as possible after bid opening. Award of bid is subject to approval by the Alamosa City Council.

The City of Alamosa reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive formalities and informalities, and to award orders for the items described either in whole or in part, if it seems to be in the best interest of the City to do so.
