POLICE ASK FOR HELP IN SEARCH FOR 71-YEAR-OLD JOHN CIZEK

John C. Cizek, DOB: 7-14-44, was last seen on June 12 at the McDonald's in Alamosa, Colorado. He was traveling in a 2016 Minnie Winnie Winnebago. Mr. Cizek's disappearance is considered suspicious and police are asking for help from anyone who may have seen him.

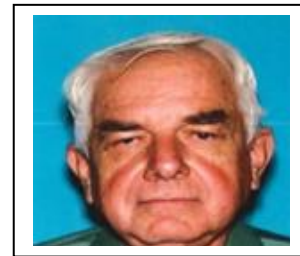

Investigators are also interested in the movements of David Edward Little, DOB: 2-17-76. Little is known to have acquaintances in Alamosa. Detectives believe that he and Mr. Cizek were both in Alamosa on June 12. Mr. Cizek was seen leaving the McDonalds, at 100 Craft Drive at 12:30 p.m. At 10:30 p.m. on June 12, Mr. Cizek's RV was seen at a gas station in Hooper, Colorado, about 30 miles north of Alamosa on Hwy. 285.

On June 21, David Little is alleged to have fired shots at police in Edgewater, Colorado as they were trying to arrest him on an outstanding warrant for Sexual Assault of a Child. He has been arrested and charged with numerous counts, including Attempted Murder, Second Degree Assault, and Sexual Assault of a Child. At the time of his arrest, Little provided information to police which led them to Mr. Cizek's RV which was parked at a RV park in Golden, Colorado.

Mr. Cizek had come to Colorado from California. He told friends that he was coming to Colorado to pan for gold at 10,000 feet.

The investigation into the disappearance of Mr. Cizek is being conducted by the Golden Police Department and the Alamosa Police Department has offered their assistance. If anyone has seen Mr. Cizek or Mr. Little, or has information about them, please contact Golden Police Department at 303-384-8045.
