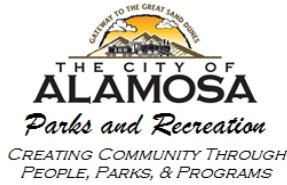

SPORTS & ACTIVITIES

Adult Sports

- **Women's Basketball:** Both team and player registration will run from August 1st –August 22nd. The captain's meeting will be held on Wednesday, July 23rd at 5:30pm at the AFRC. \$30/player and team fees are TBA. The season is set to start Sept. 4th and go through early November.

Youth Sports

- **Fall Soccer:** Come out and learn the fundamentals, skills, and rules of soccer. Games will be held on Saturdays and possibly some weekdays at Carroll Park Soccer Complex starting August 18. There are still a few spots open for ages 4-13 for \$20/participant. Coaches meetings will be held on July 30th and 31st.
- **Youth Flag Football:** This program will be a clinic style instructional program for kids in grades 2nd-6th, teaching the fundamental skills and rules of football in a NON-contact setting. Kids will be divided by age/ability level in practices. Any games conducted will be informal scrimmages. There are still a few spots open for \$20/participant.
- **Youth Basketball:** Registration goes from August 1st-October 1st for 1st-6th graders for \$20. Games are set to begin in late October.
- **Youth Ice Hockey:** Registration goes from August 1st-November 26th for Ages 5-13 for \$45. The equipment fitting is scheduled for November 26th at 5:30 pm where a \$25 cash or check deposit is required for hockey equipment. Games are set to begin in early January.
- **Youth Volleyball:** Registration goes from August 1st-January 21st for 2nd-6th graders for \$20. Games are scheduled for late February.
- **Youth Disc Golf Clinic:** Kids 5-12 can learn to play disc golf at this FREE clinic August 18th. The fun starts at 9AM; be there at 8:30 AM to register.
- **High Altitude Challenge:** Kids 13 and under are invited to join this cross-country style running series. Event is free. Races are Wednesdays at 4:30PM at the AFRC on September 5, 12, and 19.
- **NEW- Youth Sand Volleyball Clinic:** Bring the kids out for a fun, new experience in Sand Volleyball. Boys and Girls ages 7 - 14 will be directed in this clinic-style program, focusing on the fundamentals of sand volleyball and having fun. Participant Registration Deadline is Sept 8; cost is \$10. Clinic sessions are Sunday afternoons, 2pm-3pm, September 9th - September 30th @ the Carroll Park Sand Volleyball Courts.
- **NEW- Adult Sand Volleyball League:** Come join us for a Fun, Casual 4v4 Sand Volleyball league! In this mini-league, teams will play 4 games; no tournament. Each player will also receive a commemorative pint glass. Team Registration is July 17- August 27; Team Fee is \$0, but teams must register. Player Registration opens July 16; Player Fee is \$20. Captains Meeting is August 7 @ 6 PM, AFRC. Games are Sunday afternoons, tentatively 3:30pm-5:30pm, September 9th - September 30th @ the Carroll Park Sand Volleyball Courts.
- **Coed Classic Softball Tournament:** AP&R will host a coed softball tournament on Saturday, August 11 at Lee Fields. Team fee is \$250, 3 game minimum, and chose between coed and leisure divisions.

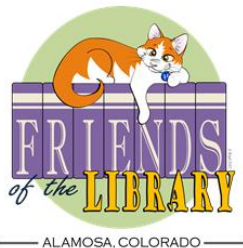
