The City of Alamosa is joining cities nationwide for **AMERICA'S NIGHT OUT AGAINST CRIME.**

On Tuesday, August 7<sup>th</sup>, neighborhoods throughout Alamosa are being invited to join forces with thousands of communities nationwide for the **35<sup>th</sup> Annual National Night Out** crime and drug prevention event. This is the 1<sup>st</sup> Annual National Night Event which is sponsored by the National Association of Town Watch (NATW) and Co-sponsored by the Alamosa Police Department, will involve over 16, 500 communities from all 50 states. In all, over 38.5 Million people are expected to participate in **America's Night Out Against Crime.**

National Night Out is designed to: (1) Heighten Crime and Drug Prevention Awareness; (2) Generate support for, and participation in, local anticrime efforts; (3) Strengthen neighborhood spirit and police community partnerships; and (4) Send a message to criminals letting them know neighborhoods are organized and fighting back to keep their neighborhoods safe.

This is a night for America to stand together to promote awareness, safety and neighborhood unity. National Night Out showcases the vital importance of Police-community partnerships and citizen involvement in our fight to build a safer nation.
