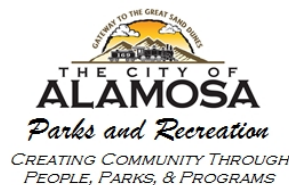

SPORTS & ACTIVITIES

Adult Sports

- **Men's Basketball:** Team registration is now closed. Players can still sign up but must pay the \$30 fee before their first game

Youth Sports

- **Youth Basketball:** Games have begun and will run through December 15th.
- **Denver Nuggets Skills Challenge:** Kids between the ages of 7-13 are invited to test their skills in dribbling, passing, and throwing in our annual Denver Nuggets Skills Challenge! The event will take place Wednesday, December 5th at 5:30pm at the AFRC. The cost is free to all participants and parents are encouraged to come cheer the kids on.
- **Youth Ice Hockey:** Registration goes from August 1st-November 26th for Ages 5-13 for \$45. Late registrations are available for a \$5 fee. If you missed the equipment fitting on November 26th, schedule an appointment with Don Mendoza to get your gear for the 2019 Hockey season. A \$25 deposit is required at the time of the fitting in cash, check, or credit card. Games are set to begin in early January.
- **Youth Volleyball:** Registration goes from August 1st-January 21st for 2nd-6th graders for \$20. Games are scheduled for late February.

Multi-Purpose Facility/Ice Rink

- **Beginner Skating:** The Beginner Class is designed for first time skaters and those with minimal time on ice skates. Classes are Sundays from 5:00pm-5:45pm and Monday from 5:45pm-6:30pm. Starting December 3rd, lessons will be on Saturdays and Sundays from 5:00pm-5:45pm. The fee is \$7 and it covers the one-day class and skate rental.
- **Beginner Plus Skating:** The Beginner Plus Class is designed for mid to average skaters and those with average or more time on ice skates. Classes are Sundays and Wednesdays from 5:45pm-6:30pm. Starting December 3rd, lessons will be on Saturdays and Sundays from 5:45pm-6:30pm. The fee is \$7 and it covers the one-day class and skate rental.
- **Recreational Adult Drop-In Hockey:** Participants must be 14 years old or older with full equipment and a signed waiver. If under age 18, a parent/guardian must sign the participant waiver for each session. Sessions are held on Sunday and Monday evenings from 6:45pm-8:15pm. Starting December 3rd, drop-in sessions will be on Sunday from 6:45pm-8:15pm and Wednesdays from 7:15pm-8:45pm. The fee is \$5/session with the exception of goalies, who may play for free after they check in.
- **Competitive Adult Drop-In Hockey:** Participants must be 16 years old or older with full equipment and a signed waiver. If under age 18, a parent/guardian must sign the participant waiver for each session. Sessions are held on Sunday and Monday evenings from 8:30pm-10:00pm. Starting December 3rd, drop-in sessions will be on Sunday from 8:30pm-10:00pm and Wednesdays from 9:00pm-10:30pm. The fee is \$5/session with the exception of goalies, who may play for free after they check in.

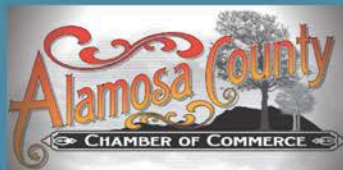
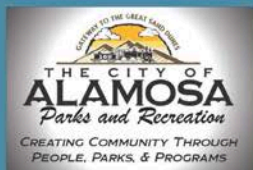
