The Alamosa Police Department would like to remind you that your dog license expires every year on December 31st. As required by Colorado State Law and City of Alamosa Ordinance which requires all dogs in a household shall be vaccinated, **Section 3-96** and licensed annually, **Section 3-51**. Each dog in your household must be registered with the City of Alamosa by January 31, 2019. You may register your dog for a license at the Alamosa Police Department, 425 4th Street, Monday through Friday between the hours 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. unless other arrangements have been made.

The license fee for a dog which is neutered or spayed is \$2.00. The fee for a dog which is **not** neutered or spayed is \$10.00. You will need to provide a certificate of your dog's current rabies vaccination and a certificate that your dog has been neutered or spayed for department records at the time of registration. All certificates will be returned to you with the new license and tag. It is important to ensure each dog must have the following tags on their collar or harness at all times; proof of vaccination and city registration.

City Ordinances:

Sec. 3-96. - Vaccination required.

All dogs and potbelly pigs three (3) months of age or older shall be vaccinated against rabies. All dogs and potbelly pigs vaccinated at three (3) months of age or older shall be revaccinated at one (1) year of age and thereafter at intervals recommended in the current *Compendium of Animal Rabies Vaccines*. If any dog or potbelly pig is found within the city without a current rabies vaccination tag or current license tag affixed to its collar or harness, the owner of such dog or potbelly pig shall be presumed to have violated the provision of this article.

Sec. 3-51. - License fees.

(a) A license shall be issued after payment of the applicable fee:

- (1) Each dog or potbelly pig, under one (1) year of age, per year \$2.00
- (2) Each neutered/spayed dog or potbelly pig, per year \$2.00
- (3) All other dogs or potbelly pigs, each, per year \$10.00

(b) Seeing-eye dogs, hearing dogs or governmental police dogs shall be licensed without fee.
