Reading Ranger Program at Alamosa Public Library

Alamosa Public Library is pleased to announce a partnership with Great Sand Dunes National Park and Preserve to bring you a new program on Alamosa Elementary's early release days! Reading Ranger is a traditional story-time program that introduces children to what a Park Ranger does in the community. The 30-minute program focuses on the Ranger's passion for the library and, using books about the area's plants, animals, cultures, history, sky, Great Sand Dunes, and the National Park service, seeks to inform children about the natural world right in their backyard! One session will be held each month in January, February, and March at Alamosa Library on early release days, starting at 2 pm. The program will kick off on January 16, 2019, followed by a session on February 20 and March 6. This program is geared toward children ages 5-10, but all ages are welcome!
