Snowplowing Priorities Explained

Street crews are working as quickly and efficiently as possible to ensure streets are clear. Crews follow routes based on the street priority below.

Priority One: Emergency routes including access to the hospital, fire stations, schools, and primary travel routes that carry the most traffic. Important two-lane thoroughfares are plowed continuously during snow operations.

Priority Two: Primary travel routes, school bus routes, and streets that serve commercial/industrial zones.

Priority Three: All remaining streets including residential are plowed after snowfall stops and after priority two streets are cleared.

Crews will be returning tonight to clear out the snow downtown.

REMEMBER:

Residents are responsible for clearing their sidewalks within 24 hours after the snowfall.
