DOLA Small Business Relief Grant

Alamosa, CO - The City of Alamosa is participating in the State of Colorado's Small Business Relief Program (SBRP) that was created to allocate money to eligible small businesses operating within the city of Alamosa. These are grant funds that do not need to be paid back and applications are accepted until February 8, 2021 and funds will be dispersed by February 12, 2021.

Eligible businesses are restaurants, bars, distilleries, wineries, breweries, caterers, movie theaters and fitness or recreational sports centers with revenues under \$2.5 million. The business must be a corporation, limited liability company, partnership, or sole proprietorship in good standing with all licenses and founded prior to March 26, 2020. Businesses must have at least one employee unless they are a sole proprietorship, and they must have a reduced revenue of at least 20 percent due to capacity restrictions from public health orders. It is open to those who are under state-mandated severe capacity restrictions that began on December 10 or before, and are still under those restrictions through December 31. The entity must be in compliance with all public health restrictions.

The final award amount is dependent upon the number of qualified applicants. Maximum awards are as follows:

- Receipts less than \$500,000 - \$3,500
- Receipts between \$500,000 - \$1 million - \$5,000
- Receipts between \$1 million and \$2.5 million - \$7,000
