Alamosa, CO - Alamosa Public Library invites the whole community for an “EggSighting” Scavenger Hunt in celebration of National Library Week. Visit the library during open hours the week of April 5-9 and *peep* around for one of four large eggs *nesting* inside the library.

Once found, reach inside and *peck* out a title. Then find the item on the *shell-f* and give it to the librari-*hen* at the front desk for a small prize and a raffle ticket. *Hen-ter* the raffle for a chance to win one or both *Grade A* prizes on display! *Dozen*’t that sound *egg-citing*?

International Dark Sky Week 2021 coincides with National Library Week so children are encouraged to “Discover the Night” and pick up a Dark Sky Project Pack at Alamosa Public Library anytime between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday (4/5) through Friday (4/9).

It will contain stickers, craft ideas, supplies, information on the importance of dark skies and an official Junior Ranger Night Explorer Activity Guide from Great Sand Dunes National Park and Preserve. In 2019, Great Sand Dunes was certified as an International Dark Sky Park by the International Dark-Sky Association (IDA). Prospective Junior Rangers are invited to return their activity guide to Great Sand Dunes to officially take the oath of the Junior Ranger - Night Explorer
