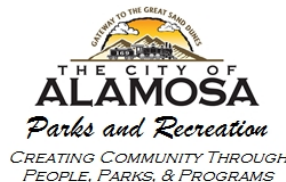

City Manager

- Listened in on the Colorado Crime Victim Advisory Board meeting where 8 complaints under the Victims Right Act have been filed against the District Attorney's Office. The State Board voted that the DA's Office was non-compliant in regards to the first 4 complaints and referred the matter to the Governor's Office. **This is the first time in 30 years that a referral to the Governor's Office had to be made.** The cases included Vehicular Homicide, Domestic Violence, and Elderly Abuse. The office has also received 4 more complaints that will be reviewed that include Vehicular Homicide, Assault on a Peace Officer, Domestic Violence, and Sexual Assault on a Child.
