Alamosa, CO – On March 21, 2022, at approximately 5:50 p.m. members of the Alamosa Police Department received information on Israel “Izzy” Raya Gonzalez whereabouts. Officers responded to the area of 2nd Street and Bell Avenue and placed Israel “Izzy” Raya Gonzalez in custody without incident. Israel was transported and booked into Alamosa County Jail on First Degree Kidnapping, Criminal Attempt of First Degree Homicide, First Degree Assault, Reckless Endangerment, Possession of Weapon by a Previous Offender (POWPO), and Menacing (Felony). These charges carry a no bond hold.

Anyone with information related to this incident is urged to come forward. Please call the Alamosa Police Department Investigations Unit 719-589-2548. Those who provide information may remain anonymous.

The investigation is ongoing. As of the drafting of this press release, the victim was still hospitalized with serious life-threatening injuries. The information contained in this press release is based on preliminary information available at the time of its drafting. The Alamosa Police Department’s understanding of this incident may change as additional evidence is collected, analyzed and reviewed. The purpose of this press release is to provide timely information to the public.
