The City Council of the City of Alamosa, Colorado, hereby creates the Main Street Advisory Committee. The Main Street Advisory Committee shall be a standing advisory committee created for the purpose of identifying enhancements to the Central Business District to create a more vibrant and welcoming downtown. Council shall appoint eight representatives representing stakeholder categories and two ex-officio members to the Committee. The initial appointment term will include one two-year term and one four-year term for each category to create staggered terms with future terms to be at four years. The appointments will consist of the following from the central business district:

- Two representing the Hospitality Industry (Restaurant/Hotel)
- Two representing the Retail Industry
- Two representing Property Owners
- One At-Large Member (four-year term)
- Council Member

Two Ex-Officio Members shall also serve on the committee:

- Chamber of Commerce Director
- Marketing District Director

While not a requirement, applicants are encouraged to be involved in the Alamosa Chamber of Commerce.
