



Social Media Policy

The City will not edit or alter comments or posts by citizens. In general, the City will allow greater scope for leaving questionable comments directed toward City Council, City Manager and Department Heads than it will for questionable comments directed toward other City personnel. The following forms of content will be deleted, and if the poster persists in repeated posting of such comments, the poster will be blocked:

- Obscene, profane, explicit, or racist language;
- Potentially libelous statements, personal attacks, threats, harassment, insults, or language inciting violence;
- Content that promotes, fosters, or perpetuates discrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, age, religion, gender, marital status, status with regard to public assistance, national origin, physical or mental disability, sexual orientation, or political party;
- Sexual content or links to sexual content;
- Campaign-related posts of any kind;
- Commercial product promotions or solicitations/spam;
- Conduct or encouragement of illegal activity;
- Information that may tend to compromise the safety or security of the public or public systems.
